

INTRODUCTION
ELEMENTARY NEW TESTAMENT GREEK

- I. COURSE OBJECTIVES - In order to complete successfully this course the student must be able to:
- A. Use with facility all vocabulary and grammar constructions found within lessons 1-33.
 - B. Recognize both oral and written expressions commensurate with the material in the text.
 - C. Translate Greek to English sentences orally from the book without reference to any aides.
 - D. Answer all study questions in the study guide.
- II. COURSE DESCRIPTION.
- A. The aim of this course is to give the student the basic grammatical forms which must be learned, instruction in some of the more common uses of these forms so that they may be used in reading and practice, together with a basic vocabulary to enable the student to begin reading the Greek New Testament.
 - B. New Testament Greek for Beginners is divided into 33 lessons. The first semester's work includes lessons 1-18. The second semester's work includes lessons 19-33. The teaching aim of each lesson is the memorization of vocabulary and any forms presented, and practice in the use of these words and forms.
 - C. Only one exam will be given. The exam may have both study questions and translation, or it may consist of study questions only, or translations only. If the student can answer the study questions without help and can translate the assigned sentences in the text without help, he will not have any difficulty passing the exam.
